Let's Analyze the Berlin Wall, an iconic symbol of
the Cold War.

The Cold War

- The two main super powers in the Cold War were the United States and the Soviet Union.
- The Soviet Union wanted to expand it's territory and spread Communism.
- The United States wanted to stop the spread of Communism and protect Democracy.



The Berlin Wall divided Communist East Berlin from West Berlin. We are going to take a look at what it might have felt like to have been in this picture. This activity is called hide and seek.

The Berlin Wall designed to keep people in the East.

The picture was of East Berliners constructing the wall.

The Berlin wall was a symbol of the Cold War and stood for 28 years as a division between the Soviets and the Allies.
