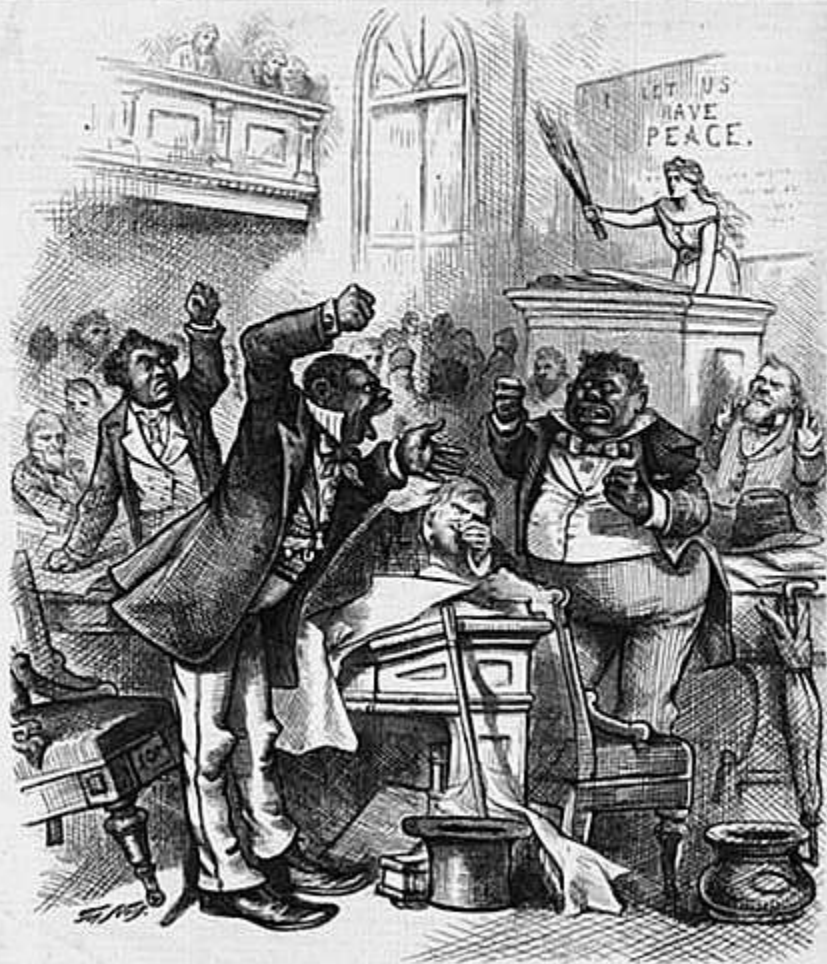

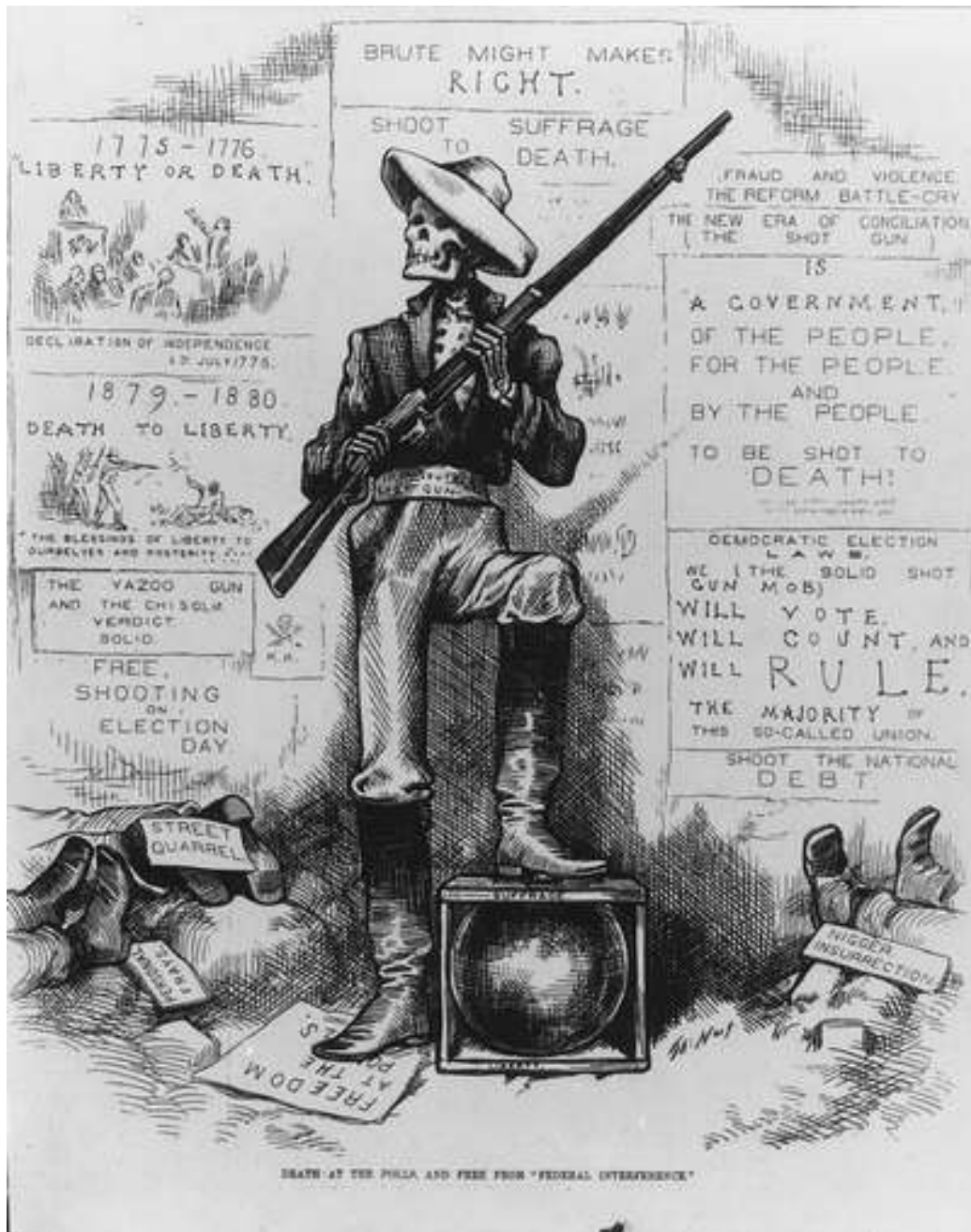


COLORED RULE IN A RECONSTRUCTED STATE.—(See Page 191.)
